- I confirm that the Member can swim at least 25 metres, is confident in the water while wearing light clothing, and will wear a buoyancy aid whenever required on or near the water. - I confirm that the Member will always comply with SGSC & BLYM rules, the SGSC Standard Operating Procedures, & the instructions of SGSC leaders, including in relation to handling boats, wearing buoyancy aids, and wearing suitable clothing for the conditions. - I understand that SGSC may limit or stop the Member's participation in any activity if, in the judgement of the session leader, it is not safe for the Member to continue or if instructions are not being followed. - I consent to first aid, including application of plasters, being given to the Member where appropriate and, in an emergency, to SGSC leaders seeking or arranging urgent medical treatment for the Member and taking reasonable decisions in the Member's best interests if I cannot be reached. - I understand that sailing and water sports involve inherent risks, including the risk of injury and damage to property, and I accept those inherent risks on behalf of myself or the Member, as applicable, while taking part in SGSC activities. - I understand that SGSC does not provide personal accident cover for Members, Volunteers, or Instructors, and that they may arrange their own personal accident cover. - I understand that SGSC, including directors, officers, volunteers and members acting in connection with SGSC activities, does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to property, or for any other loss or injury arising out of or during the member's activities with SGSC, except to the extent caused by negligence. - I accept responsibility for any injury, loss, or damage to the extent caused by the Member's negligence or deliberate act. - I confirm that the Member will not take part in any SGSC session if they are unfit to do so, including because of illness, injury, alcohol, drugs, or any other impairment. - I agree to pay all fees and charges due for membership, sessions, and any booked activities in accordance with SGSC's fees and payment deadlines and as communicated to members. - I understand that membership fees and subscriptions are non-refundable except where the Directors decide otherwise in exceptional circumstances. - I agree that SGSC may use and store the information provided in this form for the purposes of running SGSC safely and properly, including for emergencies and safeguarding. I understand that SGSC may share relevant information with BLYM and emergency services where necessary. I understand that SGSC will normally keep this information for up to 6 years after the end of the relevant season, and longer only where needed for safeguarding, legal, insurance, or regulatory reasons.
